Valley Now! Enrollment Process

Step 1

- Fill out the Valley Now! Concurrent Enrollment Packet Questionnaire.
- Please make sure to use an email address that can receive messages and is checked frequently.
(Please do not use the email address provided by your high school or adult school.)

Step 2

- Create an OpenCCC.net account at:
<https://www.opencccapply.net/gateway/apply?cccMisCode=982>
- Once registered please note your CCC ID is not your SBVC student ID#.

Step 3

- Apply to SBVC by signing in to the OpenCCC account you created in step 2.
- Apply to SBVC for the term you wish to attend classes.
- A confirmation email will be sent to you.
(Your confirmation # is not your SBVC student ID#.)
- A second email will contain your SBVC student ID number for you to use to complete registration.

Step 4

- After applying, students will receive their concurrent enrollment forms at the email provided within 10 business days.

Step 5

- Complete the "Submit Your Signed Concurrent Enrollment Packet" questionnaire page and upload your enrollment forms.

Step 6/7

- Complete SBVC Orientation and Assessment processes. Both are located on the WebAdvisor site under the "Academic Planning" tab.

Step 8

- Students must schedule an appointment with one of our All Valley Now! counselors. Instructions on how to schedule the appointment will be emailed.

Step 9

- Register for classes on WebAdvisor.

* The Valley Now! program currently only includes select courses that we have chosen in partnership with participating schools and districts.
